

ASSETS:LIFE INSURANCE:

On Page 3 of Registration dated August 24, 1942 is recorded the following:-

"B.C. Mutual Benefit Association. \$2500.00. Policy Number unknown. Beneficiary wife, Masu. Policy in own possession".

As Life Insurance did not vest with the Custodian, no action was taken in respect to same.

BOND:

A Bond for \$500.00 is revealed in letter Oct. 12, 1943 of Singer Sewing Machine Co., held by that Company in behalf of Motoji YANAGISAWA. Our letter 21-10-43 advises that Company that the Custodian has no objection to the War Bond being turned over to him. No further action by this office.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE:

Singer Sewing Machine Co. advised that they owed Motoji YANAGISAWA \$258.07 and on March 25th, 1943 we received that amount from them for his credit on our books. Subsequently this was forwarded to him in 3 separate cheques.

REFUND

Refunds from the B.C. Electric Railway Co. amounting to \$15.55 were received and credited to his account. These refunds related to 1766 Franklin Street the property of Hirohito YANAGISAWA(son) and Masu YANAGISAWA(wife) and in remitting it is suggested by the Accounting Department that rather than make a transfer to joint account 6773/12036 that the funds be remitted to Motoji YANAGISAWA and Masu YANAGISAWA, and it is proposed to forward these funds in that manner as satisfying the circumstances.

LIABILITIES:

The following indebtedness in respect to Motoji YANAGISAWA is revealed on the file:-

1. Government of B.C. - \$40.00. By letter of May 11/42 the Government advise that the account was paid in full.
2. Kikujiro TANAKA(New Fish Market)-\$6.79. This claim was submitted to Motoji YANAGISAWA and he denied same by letter June 10th, 1943. TANAKA was advised of this reply and no further action was taken by this office.
3. Sebastian Milton Reider Mortgage \$750.00:as Guarantor. This Mortgage was released as October 18th, 1944 and accordingly Motoji YANAGISAWA was released as guarantor.

Dear Sir:-

We have brought forward your file for review and for examination of your affairs that have come under Custodian control preparatory to making a brief report to you.


The file indicates that the matters in which you were interested that came to our attention have been all dealt with fully, such as your account against the Singer Sewing Machine Co. and the War Bond which they held in your behalf. You received through this office the sum of \$258.07 received from them. They were given authority to release to you the Bond as indicated in our letter of Oct. 21, 1943 to you.

In August of last year we received refunds from the B.C. Electric Railway Co. Ltd. amounting to \$15.55 on account of deposits for gas and light in respect to 1766 Franklin Street. This was received in the name of M. YANAGISAWA and was credited to your account on our books. As your wife has the same initial to her first name, and as she and your son Hirohito were the registered owners of that property, we have made our cheque to you and Masu YANAGISAWA for that amount to cover the situation, and to forward your remaining balance on our books.

The foregoing and previous letters, reports and statements appear to account for your interests that have come under our control and we shall be obliged if you will confirm same when acknowledging this letter and the attached cheque.

Winnipeg has a war bond for \$500.00.

He paid weekly sums into this account at 742 Granville
St which was in turn remitted to Winnipeg.

an eye operation.

I have informed Yana that we cannot do anything for him
and that he will have to write the Custodian in Vancouver.
