Yukitaro YOSHIDA died at Grand Forks, B. C. on April 29, 1945, at the age of 80 years. According to information from the R. C. M. P., the deceased was single and had no relatives.

YOSHIDA declared no assets to the Custodian and none appear on the file.

The only claim filed against the deceased is for the sum of \$92.20 to cover funeral expenses paid by the B. C. Security Commission. They were advised that the deceased had no assets from which to pay their claim.
