Re: Tokusuke YOSHIKI, Registration No. 09314

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on November 30, 1942. He had been evacuated on September 14, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a pump, 2 boxes of dishes and an electric heater left at the Hillcrest Lumber Co., Duncan, B.C. These were sold at auction on February 10, 1944 and the net proceeds in the amount of \$4.91 was credited to this man.

100 lbs. of sugar were seized by the R.C.M.P. prior to this man's leaving Duncan and this was turned over to this office, sold by us and the net proceeds in the amount of \$3.98 were credited to the account of this man.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$6.28 received as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

" CRIME REPORT "

Re: YOSHIKI, Tokusuki. - Sugar Hoarding.

1. Re the above, I wish to report that, as the result of complaints received re large quantities of sugar being delivered to Japanese residents at Hillcrest, B.C. Contrary to Order 97, Wartime Prices and Trade Board, Volume 6, Page 15. C.I.B. Special Circular.
2. Wednesday, February 25th, 1942. The undersigned in company with Csts Ross and Deans proceeded to Hillcrest at 8.10 pm and went to the above named Japanese residence, questioned him re the amount of sugar he had on hand, he had on hand a 100 pound sack unopened, and also about 50 pounds in an earthenware crock.
3. A check-up was then made of those living in the place, which numbered 24 people in all, which figures out at 18 pounds a week, allowing $\frac{1}{2}$ of a pound per person, and they being allowed only two weeks supply at a time, had 94 pounds over and above their allotment. We then took possession of the 100 pound sack; on making further enquiries, this purchase was made on February 13th, 1942 from Komura Bros. 269 Powell St., Vancouver, B.C.
4. I would be pleased to hear from the Department if they wish any further steps taken in this matter, owing to the fact that these Japanese are preparing to leave the Defence Zone. To Date no charge has been laid. Extra Copies enclosed, herewith.


