With regard to your offer of \$1.00 per month in settling Dr. Spohn's account, that will be satisfactory if you cannot make the remittance any larger. The remittance should be sent to the Custodian of Enemy Property each month. We suppose that your first remittance will cover the months of November, December, January and February and therefore save additional correspondence. ✓

Since last writing you we have received a claim from the B. C. Electric for \$1.86. The claim is made out against Fumito Usami, 254 Powell Street, Vancouver, B. C. If this claim is correct you could probably let us have a remittance to cover and get this matter straightened. There is also a claim lodged against you by Tasaburo Chaki, amounting to \$51.38. As you might prefer to settle this claim direct with Chaki, if so, kindly inform us to this effect. ✓

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of February 18 in regard to the claims filed against me. As you stated in your letter, I left some furniture, such as, beds, couch, cabinet, etc., in settlement of the back rent we owed.

Regarding the other claims, I can only say that I cannot remit them in full at present. I am not working and my youngest son is sick and has been consigned in a hospital for over five months. Since we are unable to pay his hospital bill, the government has been supplementing to the hospital for us all along. You may inquire about this matter to Mr. Trueman of the Department of Labour of this city to verify my statement.

As you can see by the above reason, I am unable to make full payment but will make part payment on some of them now and will pay the balance in small parts whenever I can.
