Any lease of the land occupied should be sent to me for inspection.

  - 3. Did you occupy this land only by verbal permission of the Company?
- As. Are you supposed to pay rent to the Company, and do you propose to continue paying it?
- 5. Was there any understanding between you and the Company that the house should become the property of the Company if and when you quit working for the Company?

If you still consider yourself owner of this house it is important that you should write me at once giving such information as you

may be able in substantiation of your claim.

If not, I shall be pleased to have your comment as to what action should be taken.


