

In his declaration of April 14, 1942, MURAKAMI declared fish nets and lines to the value of \$800.00 left in the upstairs room of his house at 118 Moncton Street, Steveston, B.C. and small farm implements to the value of \$60.00 to be left in the barn.

MURAKAMI made arrangements with one Stan Leslie to take over the tenancy of his house and look after his chattels. Mr. Leslie supplied this office with an inventory signed by MURAKAMI as being left in Leslie's care. Mr. Leslie also supplied a list of nets (see his letter October 17, 1942 and Chattel Schedule). In an arrangement between Leslie and MURAKAMI, Leslie purchased certain items of chattels (See Chattel Schedule) and on March 28th, and August 31st, 1944, the Custodian removed to storage the balance of items with the exception of an electric light stand, vacuum cleaner and lawn mower which are still in the hands of Leslie but will be picked up at a later date and disposed of.

MURAKAMI's son, Kiyoshi, File #4698, declared nets left in his father's house. Certain articles were auctioned and credited to the joint account of the father and son. As it was impossible for this office to identify the individual items, we have credited all funds realised from the auction and sale of chattels to the father's account and he in turn can make whatever arrangements required with his son.

At this time he stated the Canadian Fishing Co. were to buy some of the nets.

The only payment we have received from the above nets was on January 25/43 made out to S. Leslie covering two nets - 7 x 50 - 150 for \$50.00 and 6' x 50 - 150 for \$100.00 which we take to be the first two nets mentioned in the above list. Would you please check up with Mr. Leslie re the balance of these nets and the lines.

Kiyoshi, son of Asamatsu Murakami, also declares nets left with his father at 118 Moncton St. as follows:

The Canadian Fishing Co. took 2 of these nets and paid for them, 25/1/43.
