GENERAL SUMMARY

June 25, 1946

Re: Kumaichi IKEDA #11293

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 20, 1942, in which he reported some chattels left at the room, 671 Cordova St., Vancouver, which was being occupied by his wife. His wife, Haya IKEDA, File 9998, signed a declaration on May 26, 1942, in which she reported no chattels. It is assumed that the chattels were disposed of by her or taken away on her evacuation, as these were not found by Custodian representative who visited the premises on May 10, 1942.

This man reported the following Accounts Receivable:

Gensai NISHIDA, Redd Camp, Hope	- \$200.00	(File 13608)
Sanzo HIGASHI, Taft, B. C.	- 40.00	(File 7-2)

NISHIDA did not reply to our letters and IKEDA was so informed and given the address of the debtor on October 2, 1944. We could not locate a man named Sanso HIGASHI, and IKEDA was so informed on December 1, 1944.

IKEDA reported \$120.00 in War Savings Certificates, a \$500.00 Victory Bond, and Shares Prudential Trust Co. Ltd., Major Oil Investments Ltd. No. 1 Well, as well as \$17.00 in the Bank of Montreal, Hastings & Main. None of these came under the control of this office.

The file of this man's wife shows a life policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. of Canada, Policy #2108943. It is possible that this is the policy for which the cash surrender value has been applied.

The boat you have mentioned in your letter happens to belong to my son Hiroshi Keda, the address of whom I do not know. The only certain thing I know of his whereabouts is that he is somewhere in the province of Ontario, so if you would kindly locate his address thro the R.C.M.P. or the E.C.S.C. and enquire to him directly about this matter, then I believe you will contact the rightful owner of this boat.

As to the information you asked describing the boat, I can only supply you with very scant facts since I have never seen the boat myself. I only know that it was a speedboat and was capable of travelling 35 - 40 mi per hr.




