GENERAL SUMMARY

Masakichi YOSHIDA died at Sandon, B. C. on March 31, 1943. According to his R. C. M. P. Report, he was single and both of his parents predeceased him.

In his declaration to the Custodian, Yoshihara stated that he owned a three-roomed dwelling on property rented from the Canadian Collieries Dunsmuir Ltd., Cumberland, B. C. and household effects left in the house.

Upon investigation it was found that the dwelling was a three-roomed shack in very poor condition and that no ground rent had been paid since July 1928. Canadian Collieries Ltd. later paid the sum of \$15.00 for this and similar structures belonging to Japanese erected on their land and this amount was credited to the account of the deceased in this office.

The chattels left in the house were also found to be of small value and were later sold at Cumberland Auction #3 for a net amount of \$4.01.

It was reported by Mr. Matt Brown that the deceased owed the Brown Grocery at Cumberland the sum of \$18.72. No claim was filed with this office by the Brown Grocery and Yoshihara was not asked to confirm this debt. The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim against the estate of the deceased for the sum of \$80.00 to cover their expense in connection with the funeral of the deceased. We are, today, forwarding Custodian cheque in the amount of \$19.01, being the entire credit balance of the deceased in this office, to the Department of Labour to apply on this funeral claim.

No assets and no liabilities, other than those mentioned above, appear on this file.

We hold no funds in this name and the only assets disclosed in his file consist of personal effects stored in our Cumberland Storage and a few things of little, if any, value, left in the 3 room shack owned by him and known as House B-1, No. 1 Japanese Town, West Cumberland, B. C. This building is on land owned by the Canadian Collieries "D" Ltd., and will now revert to Company ownership.
