

With reference to the above fishing vessel which we understand is now in your charge at the pool at New Westminster, we wish on behalf of one of our fishermen, Mr. H. Wey, to offer to purchase the boat for the sum of \$300.00.

Our marked cheque for \$30.00 representing 10% of our offer is attached hereto, it being understood that if the bid is not acceptable this cheque will be returned to us.

In submitting the above offer we wish to point out that there are numerous items missing in the boat's inventory which it will be necessary for you to supply or allow before the boat can be put in running order. Following is a list of the missing items:

Storage Battery
Ignition coil
Wiring (deteriorated due to weather and
boat being tied up)
Anchor
Anchor lines
Compass

Inasmuch as the vessel's engine has not been used for quite some months now there is the possibility that certain work will have to be done and we suggest that before accepting delivery of the boat an opportunity be given to us to determine if the engine is in running order. This can be determined by Mr. Wey after the battery, coil and wiring items are adjusted.



We would also point out that from Mr. Wey's inspection the hull itself needs certain repairs as the seams are opened as well as the deck caused by the boat not being in operation and having been tied up and subject to weather conditions. This is an important consideration and we suggest you take this into account when dealing with our offer.
