Thank yes for your letter dated July 5th. Our records indicate that imporar as your brother Koso Kitagaus, Police Registration Not 10617, is concerned, property registered in his name was sold by him through Mr. Hal Pensise of Hancy for the sum of \$300.00. Tour wife, Hom Mitagaus, indicated, according to a letter we received from Mr. Hal Mension early in July, 1942, that she desired some funds but as the land was in the mass of your brother, Mr. Koso Kitagaus, we wrote to him on July 10, 1942 and acquainted him with your wife's and your wishes. In reply, your trether, Koso Kitagaus, did not agree and requested that the \$300.00 im question be sent not to Ilm Kitagaus but to himself, and the Quetodian's office has couplied with the request of Mr. Kose Kitagaus to the extent of sending him certain funds and paying certain claims for him with the remails that his remaining credit beliance with the Gustodian stands at \$2.00 only as of today's date.

Nour letter under reply now indicates that although the land may have been registered in the mane of your brother (and our search of the records indicates that it was registered in his name) in fact he had no interest in the land and that you had leaned him the money originally for taying the land which he sold.

Under the circumstances we can only suggest that you communicate direct with your brother, Kose Kitagawa, in care of Mr. A. S. Numbell, B. C. Security Commission, Lethbridge, Alberta, and it should be possible for you to make any necessary adjustment by direct negotiation between you and your brother.

If your brother agrees, glease ask him to authorize our withdesiring \$25.00 from his account to be transferred by the Custodian to your account which in turn will enable the Custodian to pay to Dr. G. Morse and to Dr. J. P. Sperling sums cool by you to the doctors in question.

MEMORANDUM

To Mr. Drowry

June 29th, 1942.

It appears that there are two registrants of the name of Kozo Kitagawa.

One (File 1380, Police Registration No.04410) is a storekeeper at Steveston who made declaration on April 20th, the other, (File 4780, Police Registration No.10617) a mill-hand, residing with his brother Denichiro Kitagawa, 17th Ave., Haney, also made declaration on April 20th that he owned no real property. The signatures are somewhat alike, but are believed to be by different parties.

Mr. Richardson discovered that a parcel of land near Haney was owned by a Kozo Kitagawa, who appears on the Assessment Roll of the Municipality of Maple Ridge. A search at the Registry office disclosed that he has title to the parcel described in "Confirmation of Ownership," and the Vesting Order covering this parcel was submitted to you on the supposition that the evidence of ownership was sufficient, and in any case advisable.
