Pirstly. The General Hospital - When my youngest son now 7 years of age was 2, through an accident was intermed in the General Hospital but we definitely paid the money up, and since then nebody in my family has been in the hospital.

Secondly - The \$5.50 of Mr Alhoshi was for a pair of trousers which were too small, so when we were evacuated I mailed it back but if he says he did not receive it and claims the money I guess it means that I have to settle it although I am positive I sent it back.

Lastly - The amount of \$220.00 of Mr Asaoka is really \$267.00. This business was on strictly business and in November 27th 1939 in the Vancouver Court House, under the registration number of 40418 it was settled.

For further deails, if they look into it at the Court House or at Williams Manson & Roe-Lawyer 716 Hall Building, Vancouver, B. C. I think they could get the detail information.

Since we did not receive any answer on this matter last time, I am writing another letter following this letter and forwarding it into the Custodian.

Dr Williams, Dentist, who did dentistry work on my daughter said that he has not yet received the money for the work he did and wanted me to send into you the enclosed sealed envelope.
