Pursuant to your request of April 28th, 1942, our representative proceeded to the above premises, interviewed J. Sumiya, and prepared a report on the position of affairs. Resultant details are shown below in the order given in your instructions relative to agents' reports.

REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY

The declarant reported that he does not own any real estate and no information has yet been divulged, as a result of our investigation, disproving that contention.

The personal property in this instance is reported to comprise rooming-house furniture and equipment indicated in detail under "Business" section.

BUSINESS

1. Location and nature of business:

Location: 639 Main Street, Vancouver, B.C.

Nature of business:
Rooming house operated under the name of "Viaduct Rooms."

2. Particulars of ownership:

Jukichi Sumiya claims to be sole proprietor which position, although not substantiated, has been indicated by the parties contacted during the course of our examination.

3. Description of financial position:

Assets:

Sumiya reported that the furniture and fixtures located in the premises constitute all his assets. As he is continuing operation of the rooming

house, our representative did not complete an inventory of the contents. However, the list attached, previously prepared by the declarant, indicates the nature of the equipment involved.

Suniya stated he had paid \$14,000 for the chattels thirteen years ago, but our representative estimates the present worth to be only a smell fraction of that sum.

Liabilities: The landlerd is Mr. J. Manhandleman, of 6414 Main St., 'an couver, B.C. Although it is reported in the JP form that the current rent is paid in full, the landlord claims \$139.00 for unpaid rentals accrued during the years 1936 and 1937. No other liabilities have been disclosed by the declarant, but we are nevertheless making further enquiries in that respect through other channels. Also the Prespetal and Dominion Governments have been requested to provide clearances regarding any amounts owing their departments.

5. Contracts affecting business:

The existence of any contracts of the above nature have not been revealed.

6. Prospects for continued operation of business:

Although the rooms are located in a very unattractive part of the Gity our representative indicates that certain Chinese parties might be interested in buying or operating as a going concern.

7. General remarks:

It is reported that the premises, and contents particularly, are in a dilapidated condition and that the revenue obtained therefrom is barely sufficient to support the proprietor.

As indicated above, the declarant had not been evacuated at the time of our investigation. A detailed examination of the property was, therefore, not made at this time. We are endeavouring to ascertain the date of Sumiya's removal in order to be in a position to take any requisite action under the circumstances. In the meantime he has been encouraged to negotiate a sale of the property and to keep us informed regarding his activities.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is suggested that with concurrence of the owner, efforts be made to sell the undertaking to a party interested in continuing operations. Failing that, the chattels should be sold by auction. . not the follows.
