K. DOI was advised of these claims on April 6, 1944 and replied on April 20, 1944, that the Imperial Oil Co. claim was not against him and that he had no connection with the Doi Bros. against whom it was filed. This claim has since been placed on files 5567-6630.

The other two claims were admitted by K. DOI but he was unable to settle. The creditors were advised of this and given his address, should they wish to contact him directly.

Funds from the Royston Savings Association and a refund of 16 Wage Deduction have since been received and will be used to settle the claims when the shares of the Royston Association have been received.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARYRe: DOI, Kenichi, Reg. No. 06195

K. DOI signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 18, 1942 and was evacuated on September 24, 1942.

CHATELS: He declared 1 sewing machine stored with Matt Brown, 1 Wicker basket and 1 box of dishes. They were all shipped on June 15, 1942 as per release on his wife's file (File 6477) and as per Matt Brown's report of September 21, 1942.

MONEYS

OWING: A refund of 1% Wage deduction in the amount of \$4.07 was received from the Provincial Collector and credited to his account.

BONDS

SHARES: Kenichi DOI was the owner of 12 \$5.00 shares in the Royston Saving Association. 8 of these shares were surrendered as security on a loan. When the funds belonging to that Association were distributed settlement was made and the net sum of \$16.24 credited to this account. We are writing to K. DOI to obtain the 4 other shares in order that funds may be released to settle outstanding claims and the balance remaining will then be remitted. (Claims paid balance remitted, October 17, 1947.)

WAR SAVINGS

CERTIFICATES: A letter was received from the registrar of War Savings Certificates regarding certificates cashed by Matt Brown, Custodian agent, for Japanese living in Cumberland and which Mr. Brown wished to have redeemed. The Custodian endorsed these certificates and the funds were received from the Registrar, in this case \$8.76. K. DOI has been advised of this and stated in reply that he had "no further interest in these War Savings Certificates". The funds are therefore being remitted to Matt Brown on this date.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

Dear Sir:

On the advice of your Head Office in Ottawa, I enclose herewith a copy of a list dated March 19th, 1946, from Matt Brown of Cumberland, B.C. together with a copy of an Affidavit attached thereto of the same date, which documents are self-explanatory. To complete the information necessary for you, I also enclose a list of the 21 x \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, showing the serial number, the name of the registered owner and the issue date in each case.

The only possible solution seems to be for these Certificates to be redeemed at their current redemption value in favour of the Custodian of Enemy Property and the cheque sent to your Office, whereupon you would be then no doubt in a position to effect the proper adjustments between the various interested parties.

Kindly advise me at your earliest convenience and meanwhile these Certificates are being held in this Office.

Perhaps I should mention that I have not acknowledged Mr. Brown's letter and do not contemplate doing so until I hear from you.


Dear Sir:
