OWING: A refund of 1% Wage deduction in the amount of \$4.07 was received from the Provincial Collector and credited to his account.

BONDS SHARRS:

Kenichi DOI was the owner of 12 \$5.00 shares in the Royston Saving Association. 8 of these shares were surrendered as security on a loan. When the funds belonging to that Association were distributed settlement was made and the net sum of \$16.24 credited to this account. We are writing to K. DOI to obtain the 4 other shares in order that funds may be released to settle outstanding claims and the balance remaining will then be remitted. (Claims paid balance remitted, October 17, 1947.)
