CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 16th, 1942, and was evacuated on May 28th, 1942, declared carpenter tools stored at 58 Moncton Street, Steveston. This property was owned by Y NAKASHIMA, File 10218. We made enquiries through our Steveston representative, Mr. W. O. Robinson, on March 12th, 1943 and he advised us on March 16th, 1943, that there were no tools moved at the time the chattels were removed from this address and referred us to List #69, dated Sept. 10/42. We wrote to the above on March 19th, 1943 and advised him that we had found no tools stored at 58 Moncton Street, and asked him to let us know if he had them in his own possession. We received no reply to this letter so must assume he either took them with him or disposed of them prior to his evacuation. On March 2/43 the Grone Storage Company asked our permission to ship a sewing machine to NAKAMURA which had been stored with them by Mr. NAKAMURA prior to his evacuation. Permission was given in our letter of March 6/43, so we assume this machine was shipped.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES & BONDS The above declared 11 War Savings Certificates valued at \$5.00 each in his own possession. He also declared a \$50.00 bond, in his own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNTS: The above declared two bank accounts, one in the Royal Bank, Main & Hastings, Vancouver, in the sum of \$400.00, and one in the Canadian Bank of Commerce, Main and Hastings, Vancouver, in the sum of \$1200.00.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

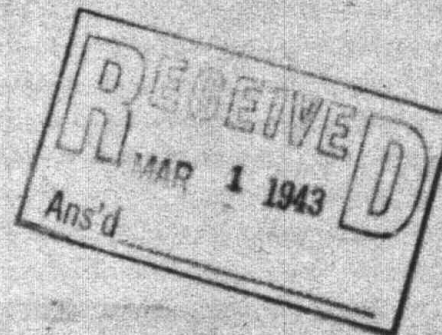
