Mrs. HAYASHI, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 17/4 and was evacuated on April 25/42, declared chattels as set forth on Chattel Schedule on file.

Goods were inventoried by Custodian agent, C.C. Achinson, on June 22/4 at House #34, Imperial Cannery (used as storage place for Japanese goods) as shown on Schedule, and sold at auction for the net sum of \$4.49 and this sum credited to the account of Mrs. HAYASHI.

Two stoves, a carpet, bed, Singer sewing machine, 2 chairs and 3 tables were not found. A small table, one wooden case and 4 screens (joined) were inventoried by the Custodian but are missing, or may have been discarded as of no value.
