



This file reveals Mrs. HAYASHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C., and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

Mrs. HAYASHI, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 17/42 and was evacuated on April 25/42, declared chattels as set forth on Chattel Schedule on file.

Goods were inventoried by Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson, on June 22/42 at House #34, Imperial Cannery (used as storage place for Japanese goods) as shown on Schedule, and sold at auction for the net sum of \$4.49 and this sum credited to the account of Mrs. HAYASHI.

Two stoves, a carpet, bed, Singer sewing machine, 2 chairs and 3 tables were not found. A small table, one wooden case and 4 screens (joined) were inventoried by the Custodian but are missing, or may have been discarded as of no value.

The file reveals Mrs. HAYASHI owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
