GENERAL SUMMARY

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 18, 1942, ten days before his evacuation.

In his declaration he reported \$30.00 in War Savings Certificates and a \$1,000.00 life insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada. Certificates and policy were in his own possession at the time of his declaration. Neither of these items were brought under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$3.51 received as refund of 15 wage deductions for 1941. This sum was remitted to him on January 19, 1944.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$2.00 received from the Victoria Lumber and Manufacturing Company, being refund of balance of War Savings Account. This sum is being remitted to this man today.



Replying to your letter of 14th instant the cheque sent to you on January 21st, 1944 would appear to have been lost in the mail.


