Re: Estate of Sada KAIURA, Deceased

Please see the attached letter signed by the three Kaiuras. This refers to two vacant lots which are owned by Sada Kaiura, deceased, on which Takumi KUROTA has been paying taxes for many years and which are used in connection with property which you are handling, registered in his name, on File No. 8552.

There will be no need to do anything at this time to straighten out the title situation. This case falls within the class discussed between Mr. Wright and myself a few days ago. It was then decided that any such matters as this should be left in statu quo, pending liquidation - at which time assets would be distributed in accordance with the interests as they appear.

The relinquishment by the three Kaiuras is not sufficient in terms, except that they state that they have no interest in Sada Kaiura's estate and so the property in question, which would otherwise fall within that estate, can be treated as belonging to Kurota. If, however, you wish to make doubly sure, you could get a similar acknowledgment from them, referring specifically to the two lots in question. I do not think, however, that this is necessary at the present time.

In reply to your letter of the 9th December we beg to advise you that the matter of winding-up the affairs of the Royston Savings Association is being given our attention, and as soon as the winding-up is complete, a distribution to shareholders will be made.

From information on our files it would appear that distribution to the shareholders will amount to the full par value of the shares, less the distribution made to shareholders in March and April of 1942.

Information on our file shows 25 shares with a par value of \$125.00 to be in your name, and that a distribution was made to you of \$51.25, leaving a balance of \$73.75.
