

The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 17/42 and was evacuated on June 5/42, declared household effects left at House #38, Imperial Cannery, as shown on Chattel Schedule on file. On June 22/42, Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson, inventoried effects found marked with the name of the above at House #34, Imperial Cannery, List #27. This House, #34, was one of the houses set aside by the Cannery for the storage of Japanese effects. These have been disposed of as noted in the Chattel Schedule on file for the net sum of \$66.31, and this sum was credited to the account of the above in this office. On June 9/43, the above sent us, through the B.C.S.C., a Custodian release requesting shipment of one trunk said to contain blankets and comforters. This trunk was delivered to the Richmond Transfer Co. on July 21/43 for shipment to the above at KASLO.
