CHATELS:

The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 17/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 11/42, declared goods as shown on Chattel Schedule on file. She also declared her personal property would be left with her uncle Mr. Shingi SATO at the same address, 92 Chatham St. Steveston. Before leaving she sold goods as shown on Schedule to Mr. MacDonald for the sum of \$70.00 which he paid direct to her. On July 30/42 she sent us a Custodian Release asking for 2 pans, 1 wash tub, Japanese dishes, 1 dinner set, cutlery and chopsticks, to be taken to the house of her grandfather, Mr. Jujiro TAMURA, at 574 East Cordova St., Vancouver. As no effects were found by the Custodian in the name of the above at 92 Chatham St., it is assumed she removed the balance of the goods or disposed of them prior to her evacuation since she was not evacuated until September, 1942.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

MONEYS
RECEIVABLE:

On June 18/46 we received from Colin D. McQuarrie, barrister, of New Westminster, a Province of British Columbia cheque in the sum of \$815.00, in payment of a claim filed on behalf of the above against the Northern Pacific Railway Co. and the B.C. Railway Co. when she was an infant, to be paid to her when she attained the age of 21 years. The total claim was \$850.00 and \$35.00 was deducted by her Solicitor, Mr. McQuarrie, for services rendered, as noted in the affidavit of June 6/46. This sum was credited to her account with this office and is her entire credit balance with us.

LIFE
INSURANCE:

The above declared a Sun Life Assurance Co. policy, #2227052, in the sum of \$1000.00, the beneficiary being her father Toyoshige TAMURA. On Sept. 21/45 a Sun Life Assurance cheque in the sum of \$199.83, being the cash surrender value of this policy, was mailed through this office to the beneficiary at Yard Creek, B.C. This cheque was not received by Toyoshige TAMURA as he had left Yard Creek. We wrote to the Postmaster at Vancouver requesting him to trace our letter of Sept. 21/45 and we also wrote the Sun Life as per our letter of Dec. 8/45.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Enclosed herewith please find cheque of the Government of British Columbia in the amount of \$815.00 payable to the above-named Shizuko Hashida (formerly Shizuko Tamura). Mrs. Hashida is presently at Tashme and has registration number 04149.

This payment is the proceeds of the sum of \$850.00 paid into Court to the credit of Mrs. Hashida when she was an infant on or about the 1st. day of May, 1924, in respect to a claim made on her behalf against the Northern Pacific Railway Company and Northern Pacific and British Columbia Railway Company.

The money was to be held in Court until the infant attained the age of twenty-one years. Early in the year 1942 Mr. H.J. Sullivan, of the firm of Sullivan & McQuarrie of this City to which I am the successor, applied for payment out of the monies with interest but was turned down by the Minister of Finance in regard to the interest. The monies had fallen into the fund under "The Unclaimed Monies Act" and it was ruled that no interest could therefore be paid. The matter was discussed with the then Attorney General and with other officials and the consensus of opinion was that if applied for a Fiat might issue to make the Crown a party to proceedings to determine whether interest would be payable. Such proceeding was never taken because of the intervention of the Japanese war.

A short time ago Mrs. Hashida asked me to make the necessary application to obtain the money out when we discussed whether it would be possible to take the proceedings previously recommended but decided against doing so in view of all the circumstances. I enclose the original Order authorizing payment out of Court of the said sum of \$815.00 and \$35.00 for my
