This is to acknowledge yours of December 18th and to give you the following information about the nets left by your family in the protected area.

We find that a number of fishing nets were also declared by your bother, Torakichi, as being stored in the basement of 122 Moncton Street in the care of Mr. Jarvis. Mr. Jarvis was to sell these nets if a suitable prospect was found.

Apparently nothing was done in this connection and on investigation in early 1944, we found that the nets had considerably depreciated after lying in the basement for two years. We removed and sold them as per our enclosure, for \$155.00 which sum has been credited to the account of your brother, Torakichi Nishii, and can be made available to either of you on receipt of a jointly signed request.
