We have received from you a copy of a letter of August 30th. addressed to you by Mr. A. L. Russell, Lethbridge, Alberta.

The letter refers to a \$50.00, War Bond said to have been left by Mr. T. Fujita at 128 1/2 West 4th. Avenue, Vancouver.

We have made an investigation at this address but the tenants have no knowledge of the subject.

If Mr. Fujita left a War Bond in a hand bag where anyone could pick it up, it is unlikely that it will be possible to locate it at this late date.

Above named is the widow of Mr. T. Fujita, who purchased a war bond of the first issue in the amount of \$90.00. This was purchased through the Canadian Japanese Association in Vancouver, and was issued through the Royal Bank there.

When this family left Vancouver, this bond was left in a lady's hand bag in the property 128 1/2 West 4th Avenue, Vancouver. It is understood that this property has been rented, and that effects stored in that property were moved to central storage.

The bond in question is not a registered bond, and the family are in some distress as to the possibility of this becoming mislaid, and ask the Custodian's office to please arrange for a careful search in this particular case.
