DECLARATION AS TO LOSS OF CAMERA RECEIPT

CANADA )  
PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA ) IN THE MATTER OF a receipt for camera  
TO WIT: ) owned by Fumie MARUYAMA, Housewife, of New Westminster,  
British Columbia, Now resident at Slocan, British Columbia.

I, Fumie MARUYAMA, Housewife, of New Westminster, British Columbia, do solemnly declare:

1. That I owned a camera, described as 6-20 Brownie Box, and have personal knowledge of the facts herein declared.
2. That I had in my possession and control at Gibson Road, New Westminster, B. C. a 6-20 Brownie Box camera.
3. On the 23rd day of March, 1942, I delivered the said camera to Corporal E. H. Clarke, of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Cloverdale, and obtained a receipt therefor.
4. That I have made a most diligent search for the said receipt in all repositories where such receipt might be. I have not found the same and I verily believe that the said receipt has been lost beyond recovery or destroyed.
5. That I have not in any way dealt with the said receipt or papers relating to the said radio and have not pledged or hypothecated the same or lodged the receipt with any person, firm or corporation as security.
6. That the sole reason for the non-production of the receipt is that it has been lost or accidentally destroyed.
7. That I desire to have this camera returned to me, as I have been informed that cameras surrendered by persons of Japanese origin may now be released to the owners.
8. That I, Fumie MARUYAMA, the owner am therefore now entitled to receive this camera.

AND I make this solemn declaration, conscientiously believing it to be true and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the Canada Evidence Act.
