Re: Estate of Tsunetaro OYE, Reg. #12161, Deceased.

Your letter of November 20th has been received.

With reference to the shares of the minor heirs as a general rule we consider it preferable for such funds to remain under the control of the Official Administrator until the beneficiary becomes of age although special circumstances might determine otherwise.

In this case as far as we are aware the minor beneficiaries named in your letter of November 14th all reside with their mother at Whitemouth Manitoba and we see no reason to exercise authority over these funds. We will therefore return to you the shares payable to the children listed below, the ages given being supplied by the Department of Labour.

Tatsumi OYE, Son - 1/6th of 2/3 share,	Born - June 23, 1928.
Toshio OYE, Son - 1/6th of 2/3 share,	Born - Jan. 5, 1931.
Shuichi OYE, Son - 1/6th of 2/3 share,	Born - Mar. 15, 1934.
Manoru OYE, Son - 1/6th of 2/3 share,	Born - Apr. 1, 1937.

As stated above special consideration is given the circumstances of each case and for that reason we are requesting that we be advised of the names of the beneficiaries and the amount payable to each before the surplussage is vouchered for through the Treasury Department. This enables our office to advise whether the Custodian wishes the funds sent to this office or disbursed by the Official Administrator in the usual manner.

Since receiving your letter of November 14th the files of the widow and adult children have been reviewed and this office would have had no objection to the funds going direct to Mrs. Kameno Oye and Tomomi Oye, but we would wish to have the share of Masaji sent here.

GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Tomoni OYE, Reg. No. 12160

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 16, 1942 and was evacuated on May 27, 1942 (?).

The only property declared was one \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in the owner's possession. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

However, the file reveals that Tomoni OYE inherited 1/6th of 2/3 share of the estate of his father, Tsumetaro OYE. This was remitted to this office by W. A. Ackland, Official Administrator at Port Alberni. Tomoni's share, \$63.01 was forwarded to him but he returned the cheque stating that he had no intention of disposing of his father's property. The cheque has been redeposited and the Department of Labour informed.

The file reveals no other property of any kind whatsoever.
