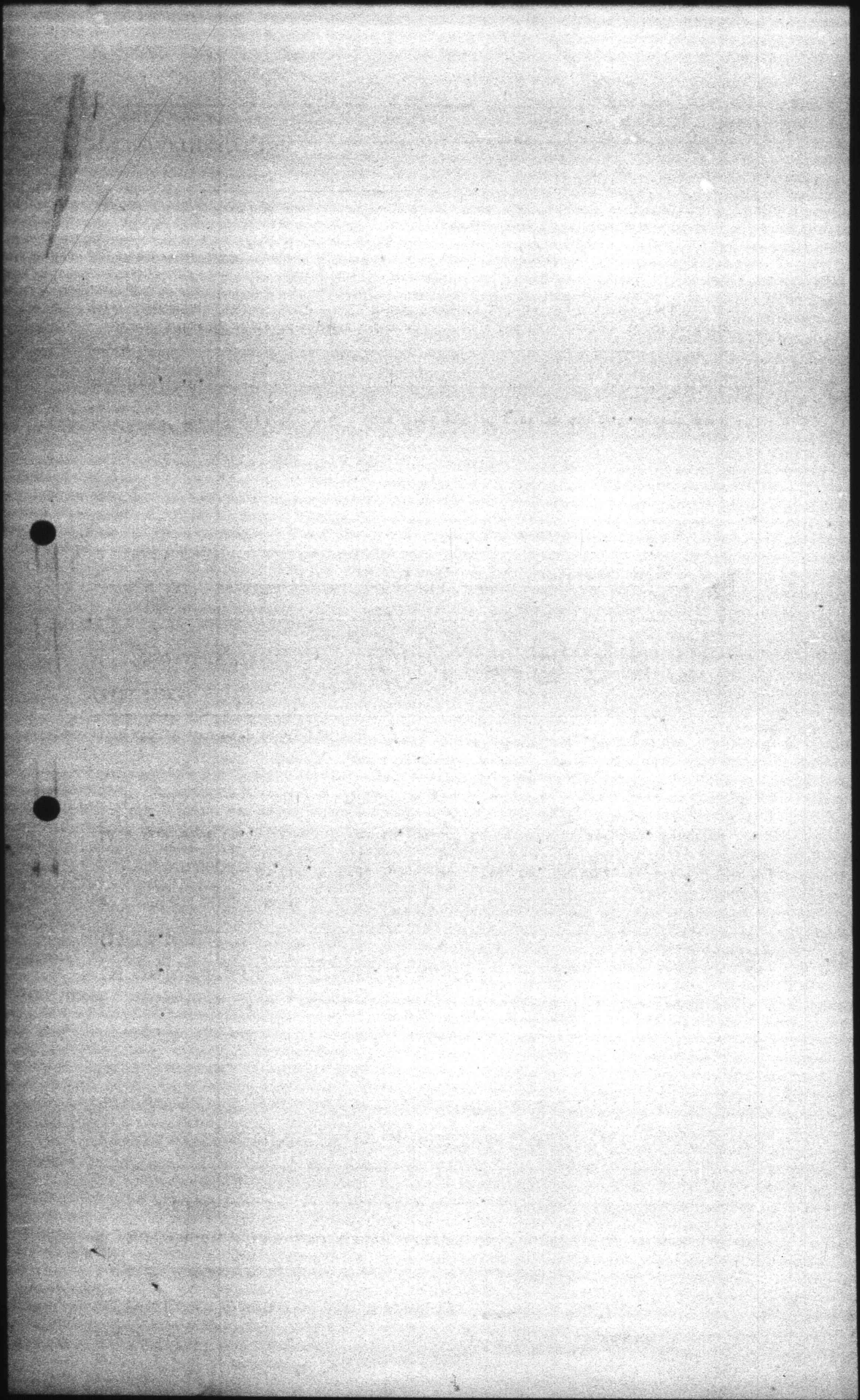

We have for acknowledgment your letter of Nov. 23rd from Fort Lewis, Washington. We received a previous letter from Petawawa, Ont. in which you asked us to reply c/o T. Shirakawa, 595 Hornby St., Vancouver. We wrote you on Nov. 14th, and enclose copy of our letter.

Your present letter lists certain items under which you write the name of K. Shirakawa, Quality Seafood, Steveston, B.C. Our file on Kiichiro Shirakawa, who we believe would be your father, indicates that fish netting and household furniture were sold by the Custodian and the proceeds remitted to Kiichiro Shirakawa.

Both your own and your father's files have been closed and the possibility of filing any claim for goods which you now state were lost, has long since passed, and we are not aware that any further action can be taken.

Dear Sir:

We are in receipt today of your undated letter. We assume that you are Yoshiaki SHIRAKAWA who registered with us on the 16th April, 1948, giving your address as P.O. Box 74, Steveston, B.C., registration No. 03442.

At that time the only property referred to was 5 pieces of fishing equipment stored at the Imperial Cannery, Steveston, B.C. This fishing equipment was sold to the B.C. Packers for \$146.80 and that amount, together with \$3.00 refund on the B.C. Electric was sent to you on December 11, 1949.

We note you were in Steveston last week and found a lot of things missing, but we do not understand what this can mean. As indicated above, we only have knowledge of the fish netting which you declared and which was sold.

As requested in your letter of November 29th, 1945, we enclose herewith our cheque for \$149.80, being the entire amount of your credit balance with the Custodian.

Your file has been reviewed and the following is noted.

On your declaration to the Custodian, dated April 16th, 1942, you stated ownership of fishing equipment consisting of twine and cork line stored at the Imperial Cannery. This equipment was sold to the B. C. Packers Ltd. for the sum of \$146.80, which amount was credited to your account.

Your account was also credited with the sum of \$3.00, being a refund from the B. C. Electric Railway Co. Ltd., security deposit for light.

You declared the ownership of \$30.00 in War Savings Certificates. These were in your own possession and did not come under the control of the Custodian.

You also declared a life insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Company, policy No. 2226386, in the sum of \$1000.00, the beneficiary being your father. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
