GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 5013

August 6, 1947

Re: Hideo FUJIMOTO, Reg.No.10479

This man formerly resided at Inverness Cannery, Skeena River, B.C. According to his JP form, he was a fisherman employed by H.Nakamura, Fanny Bay, B.C. He signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 16, 1942. He was evacuated on May 11, 1942.

In his declaration, Hideo FUJIMOTO reported ownership of personal property in his possession at Hastings Park. This property, no doubt, was taken with him on his evacuation.

He reported \$20.00 War Savings Certificares in his own possession, and a \$1,500.00 Manufacturers Life policy. None of these items came under the control of the Custodian.

The camera, Baby Brownie (Small Special) RCMP No. 782, was surrendered to the RCMP on November 9, 1942, at Solsqua Japanese Work Camp. This camera was turned over to the Custodian by the RCMP on August 16, 1944, and was sent to Hideo FUJIMOTO on August 6, 1947, by insured parcel post.
