



The net proceeds realized \$86.34 were credited to Yutetsu KAWAMURA as per sales sheets on files.

A quantity of firewood left in the garage of the Maple Ridge Buddha Mission was sold for \$18.00 and the proceeds credited to Yutetsu KAWAMURA.

REFUND

A return premium of \$3.30 was received from McGregor, Johnston & Thomas Ltd. on account of policy N.W. Fire Insurance Co. Policy #210014.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

Yutetsu's Ford Car was sold by the Custodian and realized \$550.00 as per Specified Articles Memorandum on file. Administrative expenses of \$27.23 were deducted and the balance \$522.77 remitted to him on Dec. 22/42 & March 25/43 less \$81.00 premium on N. W. Fire Insurance Policy #206630 and \$1.00 for certificate of encumbrance both of which were paid by the Custodian.



The above two files are closely connected and the same summary and schedule are being placed on both files.

The Rev. KAWAMURA, on his JP form, declared the property and buildings which were later found to be registered in the name of the Trustees of the Maple Ridge Buddha Mission. He also declared the following chattels which would appear to cover all buildings on this property:-

Our fieldmen inventoried this property 15th May, 1942, as per attached schedule. A copy was sent to Rev. KAWAMURA which he signed as correct and returned 9th Sept. 1942. (See file 13509)

All funds received from sale of chattels from the Priest's house which the Rev. KAWAMURA was occupying, were credited to his account, File 5163.

The Rev. KAWAMURA requested shipment of a great many articles from all the buildings, see Letters of Apr. 28/43 File 5163 and December 20/43, File 13509. These chattels, as per Mr. Moryson's list of 24th Feb. 1944, were shipped to the Rev. KAWAMURA at Picture Butte, and shipping charges of \$20.00 were paid to the B.C. Security Commission from KAWAMURA's account at his request on the 7th August, 1944.

Saleable chattels removed from the Priest's house on the 24th Nov. 1943, were sold at auction at Nanay on the 25th November, 1943, for the net sum of \$4.38. The property was again inspected in April, 1945, and remainder of saleable chattels from the house were sold, including the electric water pump, at auction in Nanay. Auctions took place 7th April, 10th May and 27th Sept. 1945, and the net sum of \$81.96 was credited to KAWAMURA's account.

Some slab wood by the garage was sold for \$18.00 and this sum was at first credited to Yojiro TAKAMOTO, File 8714, as TAKAMOTO had informed us that this wood belonged to him. However when the Rev. KAWAMURA enquired about this wood, after

some correspondence between the two Japanese, the money was credited to KAWAMURA in August, 1944.

The Rev. KAWAMURA visited the property with Mr. Anderson in June, 1947, and at that time KAWAMURA, personally, sold the piano from the property.

Other chattels belonging to the Mission are still stored upstairs in the Hall.

Personal property of Japanese in the District of Maple Ridge is stored on the Main floor of the Hall.

The other goods listed as sold could not definitely be connected with our fieldmen's inventory, but were evidently taken from the property. Our fieldmen did inventory 4 large electric hanging brass lamps in the Temple, and two of these may have been removed and sold.

All chattels from the Priest's house of sale value were removed and sold.

Other chattels belonging to the Mission are still stored in the upstairs of the Hall.

Personal property of Japanese in the District of Maple Ridge are stored in the Hall on the Main floor.

The above schedule is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

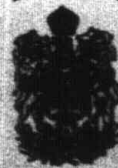

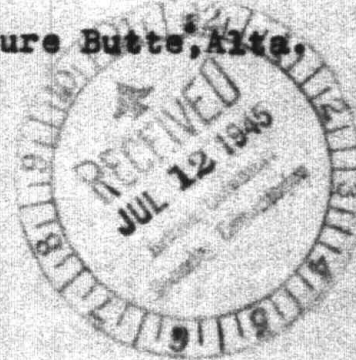

Dear Sir:

Herewith we enclose Custodian cheque in the amount of \$86.34, which is the amount of your credit balance with the Custodian, and your account is now closed.

Attached to this letter is a statement of your account from which you will note that your Ford car was sold for the sum of \$550.00 less administrative costs of \$27.23, leaving \$522.77 credited to your account. We remitted you the sum of \$200.00 on December 22nd, 1942, and the further sum of \$240.77 on March 25th, 1943, which, with the premium of \$81.00 on North West Fire Insurance policy #206360 and cost of Certificate of Encumbrance, re the Buddhist Mission property, extinguished the credit of \$522.77.

The Fire Insurance policy referred to, covering the buildings and effects of the Maple Ridge Buddhist Mission, expired on December 11th, 1945, and was renewed at that time, the premium being paid from Maple Ridge Buddhist Mission funds.

Chattels identified as yours or left in your care were sold at public auction by the Custodian in accordance with the Canadian Government regulations and the net sum realized - \$86.34, was credited to your account. Additionally the Custodian sold a quantity of fire wood left in the Mission buildings for the sum of \$18.00, this amount was credited to you as was \$3.30 return premium on North West Fire Insurance policy 210014, this policy being cancelled when your personal effects were sold.

The Custodian released to the B.C. Security Commission on February 24th, 1944, 21 parcels of effects which were shipped to you and additional forwarding charges of \$20.00 were paid on this shipment by the Custodian and charged to your account.

In order that you may acknowledge the enclosed cheque, we enclose a self addressed stamped envelope for this purpose.
