Dear Sir:

We phoned your office today, and it was suggested that we write you regarding the matter that we have in hand.

We have been asked to obtain from you, ruling as to whether or not the parties must obtain any consent, under the following circumstances:

On the 18th day of April, a Japanese, named George Tasakai, a fisherman, living in South Westminster, sold to Steve Puleo, of South Westminster, the following fishing equipment:-

- one (1) net rack,
- one (1) float house,
- one (1) wood shed and wood,

this fishing equipment being located at or near the Grain Elevators, South Westminster, for the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars. The money was paid, and the said property delivered over to the purchaser.

It is understood that immediately afterward the Japanese was evacuated; it is not known just where. The transaction was fully completed on the 18th of April, and it is now desired to know whether this should have been reported to you previous to the transaction being completed, and your consent obtained; or if, so far as your office is concerned, the transaction is in order.

We would be glad to have a reply from you at as early a date as possible.
