
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:




This Japanese person declared on April 18th, 1942, that he left a Singer Sewing Machine, gramophone and stove at 754 West 6th Ave., Vancouver. He was evacuated on May 9th, 1942.

The Custodian investigated at the house named, on November 7th, 1942 and was informed by the people there that there was nothing belonging to TSUTSUMI. A further enquiry was made by the writer on March 5th, 1946, with the same results. The Department of Labour was advised on this date, as the result of their enquiry, that Daizo KISHIMOTO (file 10391) was the former owner of the house and might know something about TSUTSUMI'S effects.

The declarant stated that he had a \$100.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No other personal property other than the above is revealed on file.

We have for acknowledgment yours of the 4th instant, relative to the above named Japanese and may say that his file reveals that he declared having left a sewing machine, gramophone and stove at 754 W. 6th Avenue, Vancouver, B. C.

Inquiries in 1942 at this address didn't disclose any Japanese property there, although, this particular house was owned by one Daizo KISHIMOTO who now lives in Grand Forks. We checked again on this house today and it would seem that KISHIMOTO may know something about TSUTSUMI'S goods and we suggest that he communicate with this man.

TSUTSUMI also registered a \$100.00 Victory bond in his own possession. There are no further assets listed.
