



This man signed a declaration to the Custodian May 28, 1942. The date of his evacuation is not revealed by the file.

In his declaration he stated that he owned no property of any kind whatsoever.

The cameras, dealt with in Specified Articles Memorandum, were reported to this office by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. On November 25, 1945, Fujitaro ONISAKI sent to this office the receipt given to him by the police when the cameras were surrendered and the cameras were mailed to him on December 1, 1945, as he requested.

Sun Life Insurance Co. of Canada policy #2125627 on the life of this man was reported to this office by the company. This policy did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The file reveals no other property of any kind.
