CHATTEL SUMMARY

The above Japanese declared on April 18/42 that he owned and left in the house of his brother, A. UNO, File 8618, at Horal Rd., New Westminster, household furnishings including, kitchen stove, heater, bureau.

Mr. UNO was evacuated on April 25/42 and in due course our fieldmen checked the chattels on the property which belonged to his brother A. UNO. A memo by Mr. Green on the J.P. form states "Mr. Anderson has a note on duplicate J.P. 'Sold and paid for'", and it is assumed therefore that UNO disposed of saleable articles before evacuation.

Under date of May 12/45 is a report of our fieldmen stating that a few articles of no value were found on the property and abandoned.

No further action with respect to chattels herein is indicated.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

What small profit I got from my sale of boat it was barely sufficient to tide my whole family after our arrival here in Manitoba. At present I am working every day and doing my utmost in keeping the family budget going. It is impossible for me to do any thing, as I am doing everything within my power to meet ends meet."

In view of what he says we shall be unable to do more to effect collection at the present time. He has no funds on hand with the Custodian and did not declare any assets, except a few household effects, when registering with the Custodian in April 1942.
