
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

The oil stove left at 34 Moncton St., Steveston, and the other goods stated as being left in charge of Yoshio NISHI, at 26 Moncton St.

All the goods found in the house of Yoshio NISHI, Int. File 1033, were inventoried by Custodian agent, Mr. C. C. Robinson, on Oct. 29/42 List #75, in the name of "Y. NISHI", and removed to central storage. It was impossible to identify the owners of the goods left in his care. 4 Chairs declared by the above were among the goods on this inventory list and the proceeds from their sale in the sum of \$2.00 were credited to her account with this office. No oil stove was found in the name of the above at 34 Moncton St. when the goods from that house were moved to storage.

As requested by you through our Mr. Peters, we report
as follows:

Your total credit balance with this office is \$2.00, this
being the proceeds derived from sale of four chairs.

Your file has been reviewed and it is noted that when you
made your declaration to the Custodian on April 23rd, 1942, you declared
some household effects left at 26 Moncton Street in care of Mr. Yoshio
NISHI. The goods from this house were removed to our storage warehouse
but no sewing machine was found among these goods. All the goods found
in this house were inventoried in the name of Mr. NISHI as it was im-
possible to identify the owners of the goods left in his care. Four chairs
declared by you were among these goods and the proceeds from their sale were
credited to your account. You also stated that you had left an oil stove
at 34 Moncton Street. No oil stove was found in your name at this address
when the goods from that house were removed.
