CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 22/42 and was evacuated on April 22/42, declared a gasboat at New Westminster and fishing net at the Imperial Cannery, Steveston. No nets in the name of the above were ever found or inventoried by Mr. C. C. Robinson, the agent of the Custodian. It was not until January 4/46, that Mr. HATTORI advised us by letter that his nets were left at the Atlas Cannery, owned by the B.C. Packers Ltd. He wrote to us again on Feb. 12/46 enclosing a letter he had received from Mr. A.H. Cross, bookkeeper of the B.C. Packers Ltd., Imperial Cannery. This letter was very misleading to the above. It is true that all nets found on the property of this company were inventoried by the Custodian and any nets sold ~~direct~~ to the B.C. Packers Ltd. were credited to the rightful accounts, but as stated above no nets in the name of Dennosuke HATTORI were found in the Atlas Cannery net house.

SPECIFIED
ARTICLES:

The fishing vessel, the "D.H.", declared by the above, was sold through the office of the Custodian for the net sum of \$380.34, and this sum credited to the account of the above.

MONEYS
RECEIVABLE:

A refund in the sum of \$2.51 was received from the B.C. Electric Railway Co. Ltd. in favour of the above in July, 1945, being security deposit for light. This sum was credited to the account of HATTORI.

BANK
ACCOUNT:

A bank account in the sum of \$150.00 was declared by the above, but no further information given. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

This vessel was released to Nelson Bros. Fisheries Ltd. from the custody of the Royal Canadian Navy on July 31, 1942, under a care and maintenance agreement. Under the terms of this agreement, replacements and repairs were effected by Nelson Bros. Fisheries Ltd., and claim for the expenses thus incurred was approved by the surveyor for Naval Service to the value of \$79.75, which sum is approved by the undersigned and accepted as adequate compensation.

In consideration of the payment of the sum of **SEVENTY-NINE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS** ----- (\$ 79.75)

(of lawful money of Canada) (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), we, the undersigned, being the owners and/or mortgagees, shipyard repairers and all others having any interest, claim or demand against the said motor vessel registered at the Port of **New Westminster, B. C.** Official or License No. **2036** DO HEREBY RELEASE and forever discharge His Majesty the King, as represented by Royal Canadian Naval Service or any patrol or auxiliary service, acting through or under the authority of Royal Canadian Naval Service, and all boards, commissions or departments of His Majesty's Canadian Government of and from claims which we may now have or which hereafter may arise and which now could or at any time hereafter be made in consequence of damage sustained or any alleged damage sustained, to the above-named motor vessel while in custody of His Majesty's Royal Canadian Naval Service or any auxiliary patrols, commissions, boards or departments hereinbefore named.

AND FURTHER, we covenant that we are the owners and/or mortgagees, shipyard repairers and all others having any interest, claim or demand against the said vessel and are the only parties or persons having any interest, claim, lien, demand or charge over the above-named motor vessel, and should any claim hereafter be made by or through any parties whatsoever, we hereby agree to indemnify and save harmless His Majesty the King as represented by any of the naval services, boards, patrols, departments, or commissions hereinbefore referred to.

AND FURTHER, that this discharge and release enures to the benefit of and is binding upon all the parties hereto, their respective heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, successors and representatives.

In your declaration of April 22nd, 1942, you declared that you had fishing nets at the Imperial Cannery in the amount of \$170.00.

As you no doubt are aware, the B.C. Packers Ltd. have numerous canneries in the Steveston area, and it was not until January 4th, 1946, that you stated in your letter that your nets were left at the Atlas Cannery which was the property of the B.C. Packers Ltd.

The letter which you received from the B.C. Packers Ltd. is very misleading as far as you are concerned. It is true that all nets found on the Company's property were taken over by the Custodian and any nets sold direct to the B.C. Packers Ltd. were credited to their rightful accounts, but as stated above, no nets were found to be in your name in the Atlas Net House.

Thank you very much for your memo dated November 20th. The relative file is attached.

As Mr. Hattori estimated the value of the gas boat "D.H." at \$900.00 and as the boat was sold for \$440.10, I feel that Mr. Hattori is entitled to receive information as to considerations which prompted the sale at a figure less than half of his estimated value.

I would appreciate your writing direct to Mr. Hattori and I would suggest that when so doing you requisition a cheque for payment to Mr. Hattori on account of \$100.00, asking Mr. Hattori at the same time to give us a clear figure of his own financial needs and telling him at the same time that he is free to communicate with us in the future as and when he requires further funds.

Mr. Hideo Fukuyama has written to us asking that you be advised more fully in regard to the boat expenses charged in connection with the above-indicated boat.

The charges made were to cover the actual out-of-pocket expenses incurred in caring for the boats; such as, fire insurance, wharfage, watchmen, appraisal and pumping. The boats were handled in as economical a fashion as possible and accurate accounts kept.

None of the office expenses in connection with the sale of boats was charged to the boat-owners, only the care and maintenance costs. The charges in connection with your boat were \$59.76.

As requested in your letter of January 15th, we have written to Mr. Dennonuke HATTORI, former owner of the boat "D.H.", as per copy of letter attached.

During the time the Committee was handling the sale of boats, all expenses in connection with mooring, guarding, pumping, ferry service, etc. were borne by Naval Service.

From the time the boats were turned over to the Custodian, the care and maintenance costs were charged against the boats, and were deducted from the proceeds of the sale. Every effort was made to keep these costs as low as possible.

We trust that our letter to Mr. Hattori will explain the deductions and regret that no explanation was given to him in our letter of May 28th.

send us any money for the purchase of a net belonging to you. This
Company always listed the owners of the nets they bought when remitting
the proceeds to us.

If we find that your net has been sold and the proceeds
credited to the wrong person, we will see that it is transferred to
your account.
