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
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 23/42 and was evacuated on April 25/42, declared a sewing machine left with Mr. K. AKAI, corner of 4th Ave. & Richmond St., Steveston, and one bed, which she stated would be left at Cannery House #7, Cold Storage Cottage, Georgia St., Steveston. No sewing machine was found in the name of the above person in the house of Kashihiro AKAI, File 4205, when the goods in his house at 670 - 4th Ave., Steveston, were inventoried by our Steveston agent, Mr. C. C. Robinson on July 9/42. No bed was found at House #7, Cold Storage Cottage, Georgia St., Steveston. It may be assumed that these two articles were taken with her when she was evacuated or otherwise disposed of.
