The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 23/42 and was evacuated on April 28/42, declared the following chattels left at the house of Yoshio NISHI, Moncton Street, Steveston, B.C.

Kitchen utensils	5 Chairs	

Chattels from this address were inventoried on Oct. 29/42, Inventory List #75, by Custodian agent, Mr. C. C. Robinson, in the name of Yoshio NISHI, Internee File 1033. A large number of goods from this list were sold direct to the B.C. Packers Ltd., among them being a large number of chairs. As a number of Japanese had goods in this house, certain items which appeared to belong to each of them were credited to their respective accounts. 5 chairs sold to the B.C. Packers Ltd. for the sum of \$2.50, were therefore credited to the account of the above. The other goods she declared could not be identified among the goods found at this house. The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

In July, 1945, the account of the above was credited with the sum of \$1.86, being a refund from the B. C. Electric Railway Company, representing refund of security deposit for light.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
