These goods were not found by our agent so we wrote to the above on Dec. 11/43 to which she replied on Jan. 12/43 that the articles she declared were in the house when she was evacuated on Sept. 16/42. Further investigations by our Steveston agent Mr. G. M. Harris in response to our enquiry of Feb. 5/44 disclosed that no chattels of any kind remained at the Gulf of Georgia Cannery.


