Ichitaro HOSAKI signed a Gustodian declaration on April 23, 1942, and was evacuated on May 23, 1942.

CHATTELS: HOSAKI declared household furniture and farm machinery leased to N.G.Park Gin with the land and buildings. From the lease on file, however it is found that the farm machinery was sold to N.G.Park Gin, the lessee, purchased the farm machinery from the Lessor for the sum of \$100.00, this money having been paid to HOSAKI. The furniture was later sold at Haney Auction #8 (June 15, 1944) for the net amount of \$90.79. This credit was erroneously placed in the account of Takeji HOSAKI, file #4779, son of Ichitaro HOSAK and transferred to the account of Ichitaro HOSAKI by requisition on August 31, 1945.

CROPS: The 1941-1942 crops consisting of Strawberries, Raspberries, Apples and Plums, growing on the Heal Property belonging to HOSAKI, were sold to N.G.Park Gin who leased the land from HOSAKI, on April 11, 1942, for the sum of \$500.00, which was paid to HOSAKI at that time.

BANK ACCOUNT: HOSAKI declared an account in the Bank of Montreal amounting to \$1500.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.
