In regard to the Claimant's claim for a fish smoking plant and float, the claim was the first intimation the Custodian has received of its possible existence. The claim does not state the geographical position of same, therefore no search is possible in other files.

In regard to the WHARF mentioned by Naoko OIKAWA in her letter of 24 Nov 46 (Ref. RP1), the VLA appraisal does not note the existence of same. Niether does it note the existence of a FLOAT as claimed by Claimant. They are more than likely the same thing.
