GENERAL SUMMARY

Yoshio ASARI, Deceased

Reg. No. 05520

Yoshio Asari died at Lillooet, B. C. on October 5, 1942. He was survived by his father, Sadajiro Asari, File No. 893 and his mother, Some, File No. 5307.

Yoshio Asari, in his "JP" form, dated April 22, 1942, declared that he had no assets and no liabilities, but on March 9, 1942 he turned over to the R. C. M. P. a Zeiss-Ikon folding camera and a Six-sixteen Brownie Box Camera. These cameras were declared by his father, Sadajiro Asari, and on May 26, 1944, were shipped to him through the Department of Labour.

Yoshio Asari also disclosed a Sun Life Insurance Policy No. 2227871 for \$1000.00 under which his father was the beneficiary. We were advised by the Sun Life Insurance Company on September 4, 1946 that the beneficiary, Sadajiro Asari, received payment of this policy in the sum of \$1000.00 on November 14, 1942.

No assets other than those mentioned above are revealed by this file and no claims are recorded on the file.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
