PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

July 17, 1946.

Re: Hikosaku KANO, Registration No. 09230

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 22, 1942. He was evacuated on July 18, 1942.

In his declaration he reported 4 boxes stored at the Japanese Hall at Hillcrest, B.C. Part of these chattels were sold at auction at Duncan and the net proceeds of \$2.90 were credited to this man's account, and the remaining chattels were shipped to Vancouver for sale and the sum of \$9.56 was credited to this man's account. The sum of \$12.46 is being remitted to KANO today.

He reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond, thirteen \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, a bank account in the Bank of Montreal, Nanaimo with a balance of \$64.10 and a bank account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Nanaimo with a balance of \$32.07. None of these items came under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$5.31 received as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941. This amount was remitted to KANO on March 3, 1944.
