

Your letter of the 29th ult. re the above. Have written Tamura that the express charges would be around \$16.00 and we will order forwarding if he wishes.

You state that normally the Commission would pay the freight charges from Duncan to Malakwa. Does this mean that your department would refund Tamura an amount equal to what the freight charges would be?

Radio equipment does not come under the free allowance of the Security Commission. The nature of the goods seems to indicate that shipment by express is the only safe method.
