This man owns no real estate.

The buildings as described in Form "JP", are erected on floats and are lying on land leased from one Low Sing, a Chinaman, outside of the Dyke. They were floated in at high tide and braced at the stern with posts.

INSURANCE

There is no insurance on the property.

FINANCIAL POSITION

This man claims to have no liabilities. I have checked his inventory as per Form "JP" and is found to be correct, with addition of 1 Row Boat, 12' long.

RECOMMENDATION

As stated, this man is leaving the key to the house in which his effects are stored, with Low Sing, the owner of the property. I would recommend that the furniture and effects be moved if possible, to a central storage.


I could not get any information out of Low Sing, a Chinese vegetable gardener, relative to this property.

I gather however, from neighbours that the Chinese rented rights on the foreshore to Kanno who erected his shack and moored his floats there.

Low Sing owns the land and Low Fat rents land from him .


