

The Gustodian is pleased to inform you that arrangements have now been completed whereby Caradian Collieries (Dunamuir) Limited, have taken ever numerous houses on their proporties that were at one time occupied by persons of the Japanese race.

'As the Company comed the land, the right to use and compay such buildings was contingent upon payment of a mominal rent. We are informed that the right of compation and use of any structure on the land was to terminate if the complex consect to be un employee of the Company. The Corporation, however, agreed to pay an estimated salvage value for the buildings, and pursuant to the agreement, the Company's Imspection Engineer, along with our agent, appraised each building on the basis of its value to the Company, in compation with their building plan.

You compled the building at Union Bay, and the award fixed as aforesaid assumted to \$40.00. Your account has, therefore, been credited with this sum.

Dear Sire

As we advised you in our letter of August 31, 1943, the Canadian Collieries (Dunsmair) Ltd. appraised your noise built on their property at Union Day, and paid a salvage value of 340.00 for it. This sum was credited to your account with this office. We now enclose Custodian cheque for this amount.

As no property of any kind belonging to you not remains under the control of the Cust disp, we are closing your account and your file.

RE: Masakagu HIGASHI, Reg. No. 06882

HIGASHI made his declaration to the Custodian on April 22/42 and was evacuated on April 24/42. He declared a shack 14' x 24' built on the property of the Canadian Collieries (Dunsmuir) Ltd. at Union Bay, B.C. This company paid salvage value on these houses and the amount paid for the nouse in which HIGASHI lived was \$40.00. This sum was paid by the Company into this office and credited to the account of HIGASHI.

HIGASHI also declared personal effects in his own possession. Mr. Matt Brown in his report dated Nov. 2/42 stated that HIGASHI would take these personal effects with him when he was evacuated.

There are no claims on file against HIGASHI.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
