PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS:

The above made her declaration to the Custodian on April 24/42 and declared household effects as noted on the J.P. form left in the house of Iwao MIYASHITA, Moncton St. and No. 1 Rd., Steveston. This house was leased by the owner, Iwao MIYASHITA, to a Mrs. Nishi, File 4302. It was later leased by the Custodian to a Mrs. Gladys Dafce who signed a list of chattels on April 30/44 left in the house for her use. Custodian agent, Mr. G. M. Harris inventoried the goods he found in this house on Dec. 11/42, List #69, in the name of Mrs. Y. NISHI, File 4302, and removed them to central storage. No goods were found on this list that could be identified as belonging to the above with the exception of 4 kitchen chairs. These were sold at Steveston auction #8 on March 1/44 for the net sum of \$1.39 and this amount was credited to the account of the above with this office. Custodian agent, Mr. J. D. Mather in his report of June 3/42 on the file of Iwao MIYASHITA, #13928, reports that the house of MIYASHITA was small and in very poor condition. Mr. Harris also reported that when he made a personal inspection of the premises he found them in a filthy condition.

It is noted that a kitchen stove was abandoned as of no value when the effects were removed from this house to storage. This may have been the stove declared by the above but there was no way of identifying it.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

MEMORANDUM

Re: YOSHIMASU, Yoshio

The above lived in a house owned by Mrs. Iwao Miyashita, (File no. 6648), near the corner of No. 1 Rd. and Moncton St., Steveston. The husband, on his J.P. form, declares:

1. A few chattels left in Yoshitaro Hashimoto's house at 54 Moncton St., (File 12252). The chattels were moved on March 2nd, 1944, and mostly sold at auction as per memo of June 10th, 1944, but there was nothing to identify any of them as belonging to the above.
2. A few articles were left in Mrs. Miyashita's house, (file 6648), in which he lived. The chattels in this house were in use by the tenant, Mrs. Gladys Dafoe, and were acknowledged by her on April 3rd, 1943 (see memo July 16th, 1943). Here again there is no way of identifying any of these goods as belonging to the above.
3. Image of Buddha, in Buddha's Temple.

The wife also declares chattels left in Mrs. Miyashita's house. Apart from 4 kitchen chairs, which were sold at our Steveston Auction #8, there is no way of identifying any of the effects as belonging to the above.

These houses are small and in very poor condition as noted on report of Mr. J. D. Mather of June 3rd, 1942.

Dear Madam:

Enclosed please find Custodian cheque in the sum of \$1.39,  
being your entire credit balance with this office, and we are accordingly  
closing your file.

Your file has been reviewed and it is noted that when you made  
your declaration to the Custodian on April 24th, 1942, you declared house-  
hold effects left in the house of Mr. Iwao MIYASHITA, Moncton and No. 1 Road,  
Steveston. Investigations reveal that Mr. MIYASHITA rented his house to a  
Mrs. Nishi, who also declared effects left in this house. Our agents reported  
that when they went to this house to remove the chattels to storage, they found  
it in a very bad condition. Our agents also reported that they found nothing  
in the house marked with your name or that could be identified as belonging to  
you with the exception of four kitchen chairs. These were sold at auction for  
the net sum of \$1.39 and this amount was credited to your account with the  
Custodian. A kitchen stove was left in the house as it was found to be of no  
saleable value.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of  
every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian,  
and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we are  
enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
