The above-mentioned lived at Dyke Road, New Westminster, B. C., before Evacuation. This property was registered in the name of his wife, Ichiyo SATO, and the proceeds from the sale of same were credited to her account with the Custodian, No. 1512. Takeshi SATO had no interest in this property whatsoever and declared his wife the landlord in his 'JP' Form dated April 24th 1942.

Bank Accounts: Declared in his 'JP' Form: "Savings Acct. Japan & Canada Trust Savings Co., 898 Powell St., Vancouver, B. C. Present balance \$14.05."

No entries were made in the ledgers of Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company for this Japanese, evidently he withdrew these funds before said Company was taken over by the Custodian.

Life Insurance: Declared in his 'JP' Form:

"\$2000.00 Monarch Life, Vancouver, B. C. Policy No. P113754. Beneficiary wife (Ichiyo). Premiums paid to date.

"1000.00 Twenty Year Endow. Manufacturers Life Ins. Co., Vancouver, B. C. Policy No. 600011. Beneficiary father-in-law (Yokichi Sato). Declarant has drawn out \$200.00 on policy. Policies in owners' possession."

Ichiyo SATO, wife of the above, requested payment from her account of premiums due on her husband's life insurance policies. Payment of premiums on the above two policies were taken from her account.

\$114.85, being the net surrender value on The Manufacturers Life Insurance Policy No. 600, 011, was forwarded to this Office February 25th 1946.

\$114.85 is the net balance after the loan amounting to \$200.00, premium arrears amounting to \$273.40 and interest on loan and arrears amounting to \$10.75 were deducted from \$599.00 being the guaranteed cash value.

The Manufacturers Life Insurance Company's cheque made out in favour of Mr. and Mrs. Takeshi SATO was forwarded to Mr. Sato on March 1st 1946.

\$392.48, being the cash surrender value on The Monarch Life Assurance Company Policy No. P113754, was forwarded to this Office February 27th 1946. \$392.48 is the net balance after the premium arrears amounting to \$108.50 and interest amounting to \$2.45 were deducted from \$503.43 being
