CHATELS:

The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 24/42 and was evacuated on June 5/42, declared a few household effects as noted on the J.P. form, left in a 4 room house at Moncton St. and No.1 Road, Steveston. Investigation reveals that this house was owned by Mrs. Iwao MIYASHITA, File 6648. With the exception of 2 kitchen chairs which were sold at auction on March 10/44 for the net amount of \$ .68, no effects were found in this house that could be identified as belonging to the above.

The above on Oct. 22/42 requested the shipment of a stove. This was not shipped as the house had been rented furnished to Mrs. Gladys Dafoe, as noted in a memo of Nov. 6/42 on file. This stove was later abandoned as worthless.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
