This file reveals Mrs. NAKAMURA owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

Mrs. NAKAMURA, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 24/42 and was evacuated on April 29/42, declared chattels as shown on the Chattel Schedule on file, at the Mio Sonjin Kai, Corner Moncton and 3rd Ave. Steveston.

All chattels from this house were inventoried in the name of Mrs. Choichiro HAMAGUCHI, File 4493, on Oct. 16/42. Goods from this inventory which could be identified as belonging to Mrs. NAKAMURA were sold at auction for the net sum of \$8.70 and this sum credited to her account with this office. One bed and mattress and 8 kitchen chairs were sold direct to the B.C. Packers Ltd. for the total sum of \$6.00 and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian.

One table, inventoried by the Custodian, is missing and a chiffonier, kitchen stove, gas stove and one trunk were not found by the Custodian.

As this house was broken into on a number of occasions it is possible that the articles not found by the Custodian were taken by thieves.

The file reveals Mrs. NAKAMURA owned no specified articles.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: She declared one \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in her own possession. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
