PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS: The above person made her declaration to the Custodian on April 24, 1942 and was evacuated on September 9, 1942. She declared household effects as noted on the J. P. Form, left at the house #18 Imperial Cannery, Steveston.

The husband of the above, Tadasu HIBI, File 5475, also declared chattels left at the same address. No effects were found at House #18 as these had been moved to house #12, one of the houses set aside by this Cannery for the storage of Japanese effects. All goods found in House #12 in the name of HIBI were inventoried on June 17, 1942 in the name of Tadasu HIBI, list #16, by Custodian Agent Mr. C. C. Robinson and moved to Central Storage. This list is found in his file 5475 and all sales have been credited to his account. It is noted that a Custodian release dated November 17, 1942 from the above was sent to us on December 4, 1942 by the B. C. Security Commission. This release requested shipment of 6 items of which only 1 baby chair, 1 baby tub and 1 double axe were shipped on May 10, 1944. The other three items were not found.
