The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 24/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 11/42, declared the following goods all located upstairs at 705 Hawkes Ave., Vancouver.

1 bed complete with spring and mattress

1 stove

3 chairs

bookcase

desk

1 table

Kitchen utensils and dishes

1 Boiler and 2 tubs

We wrote the above on April 29/43 advising her that when our agent called at this address he was advised by the tenant, Mr. Wm. Mandzuik that he had bought one bed, two bookcases, stove pipe and kitchen table from her and that she had sold or otherwise disposed of the rest of her chattels prior to her evacuation. We asked her to confirm that she had nothing left in the protected air requiring the protection of the Custodian, but received no reply to this letter. We may therefore assume that all her chattels are accounted for.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

The above declared a \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in her own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.


